EPSF was founded in 1982 as the national representative of all pharmacy students in Egypt to be the head of all Local Scientific Associations in the Egyptian pharmacy 70,000 schools. The national Federation now represents more than pharmacy students and recent graduates in 32 schools of pharmacy all around Egypt.
